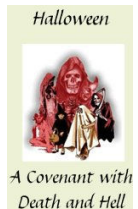

REESIE'S RECIPES



Angel Cake Surprise

Ingredients

- 1 (10 inch tube pan) angel food cake
- 1 (3 ounce) package strawberry flavored gelatin
- 1 (15 ounce) can sliced peaches
- 3 bananas
- 1 (5 ounce) package instant vanilla pudding mix
- 1 (8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple in syrup, drained

Break angel food or pound cake into bite size pieces. Put into a 9x13 inch pan (preferably glass). Dissolve 1 package of flavored gelatin in 1 cup of water and pour over cake pieces, spreading to the edges of pan. Drain the peaches and pour the juice over the gelatin in the pan. Slice bananas on top of gelatin. Arrange peach slices on top of banana slices. If desired, add crushed pineapple. Prepare instant pudding according to instructions on box and spread evenly over fruit. Spread whipped topping on top of the pudding. Try to keep the layers separate. Refrigerate at least 2 hours before serving.

Cheesy Tuna Bake

Ingredients

- 1 can (6 1/2 oz) tuna
- 1 can (10 3/4 oz) cream of mushroom soup
- 1/2 cup diced celery
- 3 tbsp. chopped onion
- 1 tbsp. melted butter
- 1 cup shredded cheese
- 1 cup drained peas
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 can refrigerator biscuits
- 1/2 cup crushed potato chips

Spread drained tuna in ungreased 9" pan or casserole dish. Sprinkle with cheese. In pan combine soup, peas, celery, milk and onion and simmer. Separate biscuits. Cut each into fourths. Pour hot soup mixture over tuna and cheese. Arrange biscuit pieces over soup. Drizzle with melted butter and sprinkle with crushed chips. Bake at 375 for 30 to 50 minutes or until golden brown.



Moist Oatmeal Cake

- 1 1/4 cup boiling water
- 1/2 cup butter
- 2 cups firmly packed brown sugar
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 cup quick oats
- 1 1/3 cup flour
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp salt

In large bowl pour boiling water over oats and butter and let stand 20 minutes. Add remaining ingredients and mix well. Pour into lightly greased and floured 13x9 baking pan. Bake 30 minutes in 350 degree oven. Spread with topping and return to oven for 5 minutes.

Brown Sugar Topping

- 1/4 cup butter
- 1 (3 1/2 oz) can flaked coconut
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans
- 1 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup evaporated milk

In small pan melt butter and stir in remaining ingredients

Salad Dressing Rolls

Ingredients

- 1 cup self rising flour
- 2 tbsp salad dressing
- 1/2 cup milk
- 2 tbsp sugar

Mix all ingredients and spoon into greased muffin cups. Bake in oven at 400 until brown.

Cowboy Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 cup Crisco
- 3/4 cup brown sugar
- 3/4 cup white sugar
- 1 1/2 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon soda
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups Quick oatmeal
- 2 eggs
- 1 package of caramel chips
- 1 cup chopped nuts

Cream crisco and sugar. Add eggs and vanilla and beat well. Sift together flour, salt, and soda, add to mixture. Add oatmeal (dough will be very stiff), butterscotch chips and nuts. Drop spoonfuls on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake at 350 degrees for 12 minutes or until brown. Cool slightly and remove from pan.

- 1 (7 oz) jar marshmallow crème
- 1 cup peanut butter
- 1/2 cup honey
- 2 (1.5 oz) chocolate bars, crumbled
- 1 1/2 cups raisins
- 1 cup walnuts

Mix first 3 ingredients with electric mixer and add next 3 ingredients. Mix well and shape on rounded teaspoon into 1 inch balls. Roll in coconut. Chill or freeze.

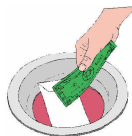
